



## General Information for the Prospective Parents

Thank you for your interest in our program. The Sligo Child Developmental Center is a non-profit operation of the Sligo Seventh-day Adventist Church/Sligo Adventist School. The Director administers the operation; the Sligo Adventist School Board sets policies.

The Center provides valuable educational experiences and fosters growth and development in all aspect of the child's life – spiritual, social, intellectual and physical. Programs are provided that serve a wide range of developmental needs. Children participate in activities designed to help them grow into independent, creative, confident and thoughtful individuals who will be able to work effectively with adults and other children.

**Prerequisite:** The child must be at least 2½ years old and toilet trained at the time of admission.

**Application:** Complete and return the application with a nonrefundable \$30.00 application fee.

**Registration:** Material fee of \$40.00 is due at the time of registration.

**Financial Arrangements:** Effective August 17, 2009 the weekly fee is \$160.00 for ages 3 – 4 and \$170.00 for under 3. The Center has a “no billing” policy. All fees are to be prepaid and are due Monday of each week. Payments paid after Wednesday will result in a \$5 late fee charge. There is a \$25.00 service charge for each “returned” check. Failure to pick-up your child(ren) on time will result in a fee of \$1.00 per minute.

**Hours of Operation for the Center:** 7:30 AM to 6:00 PM, Monday through Thursday and 7:30 AM to 4:00 PM (EST) and 5:00 (DST) on Friday's only.

Plentiful, well-balanced vegetarian meals and two snacks are provided. Candy, chewing gum and jewelry are not permitted at the Center.

Worship time each morning gives children an opportunity to come together in a group to sing Christian songs, hear Bible stories illustrated by beautiful felt figures on the felt board, learn character-building stories, role play activities that teach kindness, obedience and sharing. We want the child to learn that Jesus is their friend; He loves them and cares for them and their family.
