



Middle School Supply List

Middle school students will be provided **TWO** lockers and a lock so they can place their books and personal items in their lockers.

Backpacks that are used should be small enough to place in their locker.

Black / Blue pens for homework / class work

Red / Green pens for grading

Pencils #2

Notebook with college ruled paper

Spiral bound notebook "Journaling"

3 ring zippered pencil case (optional)

3 boxes of Kleenex (one for each classroom)

Book covers for all text books (4) Extra large covers (3)

2 Spiral notebooks

Graph paper

Quad ruled composition book (at least 100 sheets) (available Office Depot)

1 binder for Language Arts / Reading

1 binder for Science (3 ring, "1 - 1 1/2")

1 binder for Science lab (3 ring, "1 - 1 1/2")

Flash cards for multiplying and dividing (available at the Dollar Store, Ollie's, MalMart, Office Depot)

1 binder for Bible / History

1 ruler

1 Pack of erasers

Colored pencils / pens for Art

Scissors

Glue stick

You **MUST HAVE A CALCULATOR!** Phone calculators are not permitted.

6th and 7th must have a calculator with exponent and square root functions.

8th must have a graphing calculator (TI-84 Plus recommended because it will be used in high school but you must have at least a TI-73)

If you are in 7th or 8th grade and cannot afford a graphing calculator, you may check out a school calculator for the school year. The fee is to bring four AAA batteries. If the calculator is not returned at the end of the year, you will be responsible for replacing it.
